ORDER ESTABLISHING A STAFFED DIVISIONAL OFFICE
IN BECKLEY, WV

The Court has determined that there is a critical need to improve services to the members of the Bar, creditors and debtors in the rural divisions of Beckley and Bluefield, due to passage of the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005. In June 2006, the Court began offering services two days per week, using existing space in the Beckley Courthouse and staff from the Charleston Office. These limited services further reinforced the Court's opinion that the services are greatly needed in this area of the State. The Court determined that existing space should be used to establish a permanent and full time Bankruptcy Clerk's Office in the Beckley Courthouse. It is therefore

ORDERED that, effective June 11, 2007, the Beckley Division shall have a full time staffed Bankruptcy Clerk's Office. It is further

ORDERED that the Beckley Divisional Office shall be open to the public Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., closed from 1:00 pm - 2:00 pm for lunch.
