**NOTICE OF AMENDMENT TO FRBP 5005(a)(2) AND
REQUIREMENT TO FILE ALL DOCUMENTS ELECTRONICALLY**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on December 1, 2018, an Amendment to FRBP 5005(a)(2) will require all counsel representing clients to electronically file documents with the Bankruptcy Court, unless nonelectronic filing is allowed by the court for good cause or is allowed or required by local rule. Consequently, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of West Virginia will no longer accept pleadings filed on paper for those represented by counsel. Those lawyers still filing on paper must, no later than December 1, 2018, become authorized e-filers.
