ORDER APPOINTING MADELEINE JAECK AS THE EMPLOYEE DISPUTE RESOLUTION COORDINATOR FOR THE UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY COURT FOR THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT OF WEST VIRGINIA

This matter is before the Court upon the immediate need to name a permanent Employment Dispute Resolution ("EDR") Coordinator as the position has recently been vacated by the appointment of B. McKay Wyckoff as the Chief Judge of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of West Virginia.

The Court hereby appoints Madeleine Jaeck, CJA Supervising Attorney for the United States District Court for the Southern District of West Virginia to serve as the EDR Coordinator for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of West Virginia effective immediately. In the event that Madeleine Jaeck is disqualified pursuant to Section 10.7 of the Court's Consolidated Equal Employment Opportunity and Employment Dispute Resolution Plan dated July 18, 2019, Korin Parsons of the United States District Court for the Southern District of West Virginia shall continue to serve as alternate EDR Coordinator.
