GENERAL ORDER 22-05

ORDER

On September 7, 2022, (the “Applicant”), the newly appointed Standing Chapter 12 and Chapter 13 Trustee for the Northern and Southern Districts of West Virginia, requested a PACER fee exemption to enable him to perform his work as a Standing Chapter 12 and Chapter 13 Trustee in this Court. Pursuant to Item 9 of the Electronic Public Access Fee Schedule (2022), the Court may grant a PACER fee exemption to bankruptcy case trustees. In considering the application the Court finds that the Applicant has demonstrated that an exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information. Accordingly, the Applicant shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this Court, to the extent such use is incurred in the course of conducting the Applicant’s business as the Standing Chapter 12 and Standing Chapter 13 Trustee for the State of West Virginia. The Applicant shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this Court. Additionally, the following limitations apply:

1. This fee exemption applies only to the Applicant and is valid only for the purposes stated above;
2. This fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this Court that are available through the PACER system;
3. By accepting this exemption, the Applicant agrees not to sell for profit any data

obtained as a result of receiving this exemption;

4. The Applicant is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption except as is necessary in the ordinary course of the administration of Chapter 12 and Chapter 13 cases;
5. This exemption is valid from October 1, 2022, though the termination of the Applicant's tenure as the Standing Chapter 12 and Chapter 13 Trustee for the State of West Virginia, or until otherwise revoked by this Court, whichever is sooner.
