
RE: STANDING ORDER CONDITIONALLY VESTING

ORDER


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the United States Bankruptcy Court for this District be, and hereby is, authorized pursuant to Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 9029(a), and subject to the requirements of Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 83, to make and amend its local rules of practice and procedure which are consistent with -- but not duplicative of -- Acts of Congress and the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, and which do not prohibit or limit the use of the Official Forms. The local rules shall conform to any uniform numbering system prescribed by the Judicial Conference of the United States.

IT IS FURTHER HEREBY ORDERED that the aforementioned authority is subject to withdrawal if the District Court, in its sole discretion, so determines by a majority vote.




