## GENERAL ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY EXEMPTION FROM ELECTRONIC PUBLIC ACCESS (PACER) FEES

On this day the Court considered a letter dated May 25, 2006, from Jean M. Lown, Ph.D., professor of Education and Human Services, Department of Family, Consumer, and Human Development at Utah State University, requesting an exemption from electronic public access (PACER) fees for the 1-year period of June 1, 2006 to June 1, 2007, for the purpose of conducting research regarding bankruptcy filings.
