GENERAL ORDER REGARDING PURCHASE OF LOW COST VEHICLE BY CHAPTER 13 DEBTORS

It appears to the Court that Chapter 13 debtors occasionally find it necessary

to quickly obtain a replacement vehicle while their Chapter 13 case is pending and may

have the ability to purchase such vehicle without obtaining credit or incurring debt,

which require notice and Court approval under the Bankruptcy Code and Rules. It

further appears to the Court that it is in the best interests of the Chapter 13 debtors,

and their creditors, to permit the Chapter 13 debtors to quickly acquire a vehicle

without obtaining credit or incurring debt, to avoid loss of employment and other

problems which could adversely impact the debtors' ability to perform under their

Chapter 13 Plan. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that debtors in Chapter 13 cases are hereby permitted to purchase

an economical vehicle without notice to creditors or entry of an order of this Court,

provided that such purchase does not require the debtor(s) to obtain credit or incur

debt, and provided that a stipulation between the debtor(s) and the Chapter 13 Trustee

is filed with the Court that sets forth information adequately describing the vehicle, the

purchase price, the source of funds to be used, and the status of the Chapter 13 Plan

payments.
